As we prepare for a new year, and all of the opportunities it will bring, know that all of us at Nazareth School have made a heartfelt commitment to provide the best experiences possible for all of our students and their families. We look forward to working in partnership with you to celebrate the gifts of Nazareth School, our Mission and all of the members of its community. As a reminder, kindergarten through eighth grade students have required summer reading and math review packets, due to their homeroom teacher on Monday, August 19th. We are happy to provide you with an extra packet, please drop by the office to pick one up. We also have extra copies of the classroom supply lists for your convenance. Regarding supplies, it is not necessary to buy all new supplies if your child has unused materials from last year. In order to minimize costs of extra art supplies, we have eliminated the large class art supplies list. In lieu of the art supplies, we will be collecting a small \$5.00 fee per students.

As we prepare for the upcoming new school year, please make sure that your child's uniform, school supplies, and grooming are in order, please no extreme haircuts, or dyed hair. It will be a 10-12 minute ceremony, enabling students time to return to their classroom for early dismissal at 11:55 am.
