## SCHOOL RESUMES – August 19

The first day of school for the 2024-25 school year is Monday, August 19. Monday and Tuesday of the 1<sup>st</sup> week of school will be minimum days with dismissal at 11:55am. Extended Care for only K-8 will be available beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school. Wednesday, Thursday and Friday will be full days of school with dismissal at 2:45pm.

## EXTENDED CARE
