The entire faculty and staff are excited to begin the 2023-2024 academic school year! As a reminder, tomorrow is a minimum day with an 11:55 am dismissal. Regular dismissal begins Wednesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> and is at 2:45 pm.

Due to the anticipated heavy traffic, for the first day of school drop-off, you may use the parking area in front of St. Francis Chapel as well as the parking spots by the lower field lunch tables. PLEASE NOTE: these extra parking areas are only available on the first day of school and for **drop-off only**. To access these extra parking areas, you must use the back access road that is to the east of the Mission on San Diego Mission Road (look for the brown wood sign that says “Deliveries/Buses”). Please do not park in the San Diego Mission Courtyard.

For the first day of school, the PTG will be hosting a “Welcome Back Meet and Greet” at the lower field lunch tables. Please feel free to walk your child(ren) to their classroom(s) and then join us for great conversation and morning breakfast treats.

Please know that the entire faculty and staff at Nazareth School are here to support all of our students and families. In light of this, we will be offering Extended Care beginning the first day of school, opening at 7 am and closing promptly at 6 pm.
