FAMILY ENVELOPES

Nazareth School uses a Family Envelope system as a means of getting information home to parents. The envelope goes home with the eldest or only child in every family. We ask that you use this envelope to return information to the school and use it as your means of communication when necessary. The envelope goes home every Friday and should be returned on Monday and certainly no later than the following Wednesday. Parents, please sign or initial the front of the envelope in the appropriate box each week.

IMPORTANT POLICY

All volunteers and visitors must sign in at the school office and wear a "Volunteer" or "Visitor" badge to remain on the school grounds after the morning bell. All Volunteers must be CMG cleared, both the background check and safe environment. The safety and best interest of all the children is our first priority, so please check in at the office.

PERMIT TO LEAVE

Parents who need to pick up a child early must go to the office to sign him/her out. No student may leave the grounds during school hours without being signed out. Parents, please send a note or email to the teacher and to office@nazarethschool.org in the morning so your child can be ready, with homework, when you come to pick him/her up. This will cut down on classroom disruptions.

MORNING EXTENDED CARE

Morning extended care opens at 7:00am. Students must go to the extended care room or sit with you in your parked car prior to 7:50am. Any student arriving after 7:50am will not be charged for extended care services. Students arriving early will be charged up to 7:50am. Students may not go to the classroom until the 7:55am bell. The extended care fee is \$4.50 per hour.

STUDY HALL/HOMEWORK CLUB

After school Homework Club will be offered in the Extended Care room in St. Joseph's. Homework Club will be available to students Monday thru Thursday from 3:00 – 4:00pm. Students staying for Homework Club will be charged for extended care.

MEDICATIONS


If your child(ren) will be needing any medication during school hours, please stop by the office to fill out a new medical release form. We must have a new form each year.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

We have enclosed in the family envelope an Emergency Information Card and a Release Form. Please fill out both sides of the forms and return them in the family envelope. This information is very important. We refer to these forms if your child should become ill or injured, if there should be a disaster, or if someone, other than you, comes to pick up your child. Please keep this information up to date throughout the school year.

SCRIP PROGRAM

All Nazareth School families should be enrolled on raiseright.com. Please call the school if you need the Scrip enrollment code. Download the RaiseRight App to purchase egift cards, specialty scrip or reload cards. For card reloads, in order to receive credit for reloads, you must purchase the first physical card through Nazareth School.

Important: if you don't purchase your Scrip with online payment, you must print your order and bring in your payment to the office before we will order it.

Look for the Scrip order form in the family envelope. It will be sent to you every other week for your convenience. It is also available on the school website under the Parents Tab. Reminder: The Scrip Program for the 2024-25 school year runs from April 2, 2024-March 31, 2025.

RaiseRight offers no fee Visa gift cards in \$25, \$50, \$100, \$250 and \$500 denominations. These can be used at Costco too! It is however, a Special Order. The office can place orders for Visa cards or you can order with online payments. If not using online payments all orders will need to have either cash or check payment.
