Dear Wonderful Nazareth Families,

Thank you for your continued support of our Nazareth students, especially as we work through this difficult time of the Omicron variant. Please know that Nazareth School is wholeheartedly committed to supporting all students during these turbulent times, keeping in mind our mission: "to teach and guide students from various backgrounds in their spiritual, academic, physical, and social development."

We are implementing a team approach to help students who have been absent, to ensure mastery of core subjects, and to prevent learning loss. Mrs. Johnson (resource) will continue to assist her students and will work with teachers to facilitate additional instruction for absent students. Homeroom teachers will be coordinating with Mrs. McDoniel (art) and Mrs. Mendez (Spanish) and potentially using their designated class periods to support students with completing their absent work, completing missed assessments, and learning concepts they missed. Suspended art and Spanish classes will be dependent on the needs of each grade. Mrs. Martinez (library) will also be available to work with students during library. Lastly, we will be utilizing our Instructional Aides to help re-teach concepts and work in small groups with students. The Nazareth faculty and staff are committed to inperson learning and what is best for students' spiritual, emotional, and physical wellbeing, as well as their academic success. All teachers will be supporting students with office hours, available twice a week. Teachers will be emailing the dates and times for their office hours. This additional instructional opportunity will give both students, in-person and at home, a chance to ask questions and receive assistance for any classwork they missed.
