Adult Confirmation Preparation is intended for persons who are already baptized Catholics, have received First Eucharist, are at least 18 years old, and are already committed to the practice of their Catholic faith. 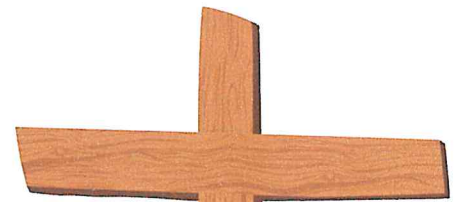
