Limiting Restrictions

It has been brought to our attention that some of the apps that are “unlocked” on the iPad are trying to pull content from websites that are not collected in the unrestricted list that was curated and setup on the iPads.


We are offering a solution to this by having you lift the restrictions while still limiting adult content.

If you feel confident applying this yourself, please follow the steps provided. If you would prefer Nazareth School to apply these changes please bring the device back to school and we will be happy to assist.

Step 1


Navigate to the second page of apps and locate the folder titled “Teachers Only”



Tap the folder “Teachers Only”

Step 2


In the “Teachers Only” folder, locate the Settings app.



Tap the Settings app

Step 3


In the Settings app, locate the “Screen Time” setting.



Tap “Screen Time”

Step 4


In the Screen Time settings, locate “Content & Privacy Restrictions”



Tap “Content & Privacy Restrictions”

Step 5


When given the prompt for a passcode enter “1072”



Enter the Passcode

Step 6


In the Content & Privacy Restrictions tab, locate “Content Restrictions”



Tap “Content Restrictions”

Step 7


In the Content Restrictions tab, locate “Web Content”



Tap “Web Content”

Step 8


In the Web Content tab, locate “Limit Adult Websites”



Tap Limit Adult Websites

Step 9

Your screen should show a checkmark next to Limit Adult Websites. Press the physical home button on the iPad and the IXL and Wonders sites (as well as other sites) will now be unrestricted.




Step 10 (Optional)

If you would like to block a specific website, such as YouTube, use the “NEVER ALLOW” option as follows:




Click “Add Website”
