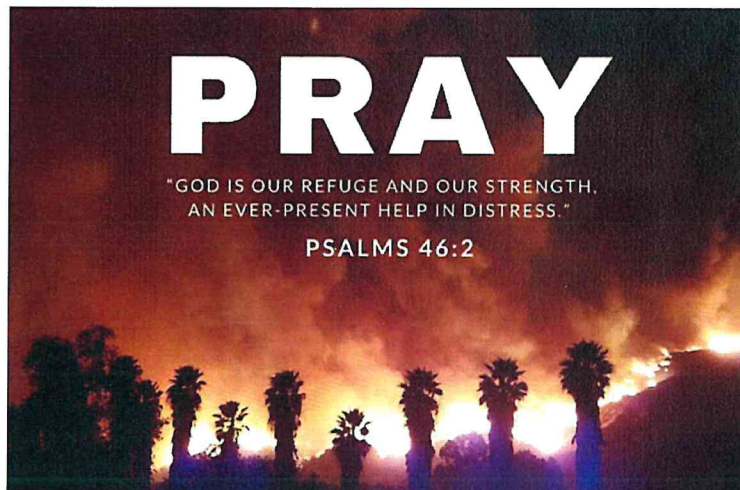

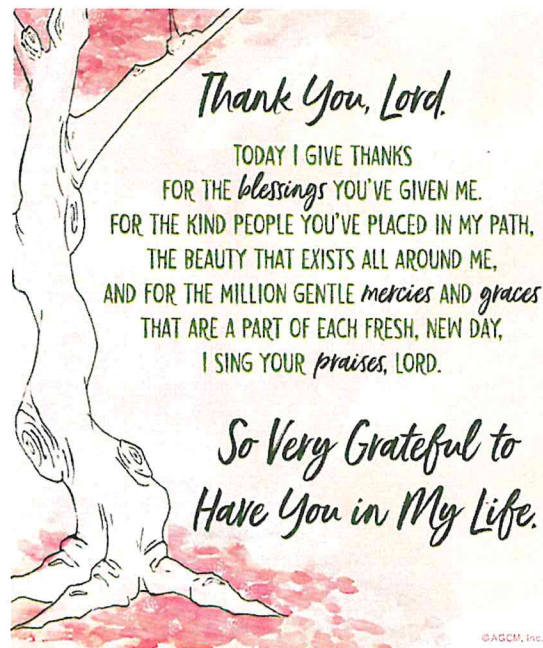
Patience
