Dear Preschool Families,

We began our week celebrating St. Patrick's Day! A special visitor traveled on Imaginary Airlines all the way from Ireland to visit us! We were delighted to see Miss Molly. She read a story and danced to Irish music. She gave the children a sticker and gold coin. Each class enjoyed a St. Patrick Day cookie and Lucky the Leprechaun left a lucky marshmallow treat.

This week the Sunflower teachers introduced the letter Mm and octagon shape. The children traced and colored an octagon. On Wednesday, each child worked on their alphabet book. They traced letter Mm and drew a picture. They ended the week making a letter collage by tearing and gluing green paper to the letter Mm.

The Buzzy Bee teachers introduced letter Qq and continued to review numbers 1-20. The Spanish word of the week was "Primavera". During geography they colored their facts book about Ireland and made an Irish dancer puppet. They ended the week completing their journal page on spring.

On Thursday, during Grotto time, we sang a song about Lent, reviewed our Core Values and read the book "God's Rules for Me" by Virginia Helen Richards, FSP and D. Thomas Halpin, FSP.

## **PARENT VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS**

Due to the health and safety of the children and staff, State Licensing requires that all volunteers submit required immunizations. Parents, anytime you sign up to volunteer or be present in any of the preschool events, you MUST be sure that you have turned in a copy of your current TB test, Tdap, MMR, flu shot and Covid card. You must also complete the CMG Connect training that you may find on our school website. The fee for the training is \$25.00. Please fill out the Statement of Good Health form too. We want to thank all the parents who have submitted the required immunizations.

#### SIGN-IN & OUT

Parents, please sign in and out as you enter the building. Full signature **NO** initials! This is a State Licensing Regulation. Just a reminder: When you sign your child out, your child is no longer under our care and you MUST take your child with you.

## **SNACKS**

I want to thank the families who brought muffins, veggies and fruit. We greatly appreciate all your help. Muffins (Wilson, Basore & Olla) and veggies (Tran). Remember to keep track of your service hours and save your receipts to attach to your Service Hour sheet and return in your white envelope. Snacks **MUST** be store bought/prepackaged. If you sign -up for your child's class, please make sure that the snack is enough for both classes.

#### PRESCHOOL OPERATING HOURS

The preschool operating hours are 7:00am to 6:00pm. Our preschool main entrance door is locked all day. You MUST ring the doorbell to come into the building during drop off and pick up. Each classroom has a monitor and we are able to see and communicate with parents. Once we click the button to let you in, you have about 5 seconds to pull and open the door.

#### **AFTERCARE**

We provide aftercare from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm (\$4.50 per hour). Aftercare pick-up is on the Northeast side of the preschool building (Sunflower Playground or Preschool Aftercare room).

#### **DROP OFF & PICK-UP ROUTE**

We want to remind you that our drop off and pick up route is a **ONE WAY ONLY!** You **MUST** drive up Nazareth Drive off of San Diego Mission Road. You may park in the parking lot to your right or pull up front to the main entrance roundabout in front of the St. Joseph's building.

Please be sure to sign your child in and walk them to class. After drop off or pick up, you **MUST** merge and continue through the school road and drive out onto Rancho Mission Road. You may **NOT** exit back down Nazareth Drive!

During pick up, if you do not have an upper grade school student, you may merge into the exit lane to your left and drive towards the parking lot and between the signs to exit. You do not have to wait in line.

If you have a preschooler and an upper grade school student, please drop off preschooler first and then upper grade student. If you exit through the door next to the Sunflower classroom, you may **NOT** come back in through that door. You **MUST** go around the building. Our preschool main entrance and exit door is located on the SW side of the St. Joseph building.

We must continue to follow the K-12 & Childcare Guide for Covid-19 (August 1, 2024)

It is very important that you call and report your child's absence. Please test your child and complete the Attestation Form that you are able to obtain from us. You MUST test your child twice before they are able to return. The first test is done when child has symptoms and the second test is 12-24 hours after first test. Your child may return when they are fever-free for 24 hours without medication AND other non-fever symptoms are mild and improving.

Parents, please keep your child home if she/he is sick and presenting any of the following Covid-19 symptoms:

- Fever with or without chills
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Nasal Congestion
- Sore Throat
- Headache
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste or smell
- Muscle or body aches
- Poor feeding or poor appetite
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have Covid-19

If your child presents any of the symptoms stated above during school time, we will have to send your child home. Please keep in mind that we continue to follow the school protocols to keep children and staff safe.

If your child has allergies, please be sure to bring in a doctor's note, otherwise we will send your child home.

Please remember to return your family envelope by Thursday each week. Place it in your child's file folder.
