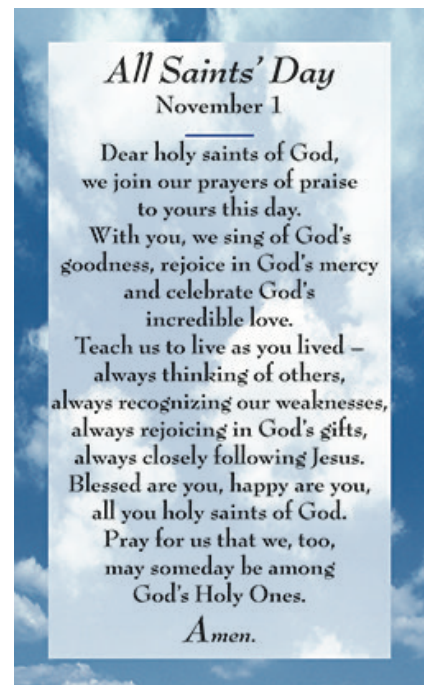
### **Halloween**
