Dear Wonderful Nazareth Families,

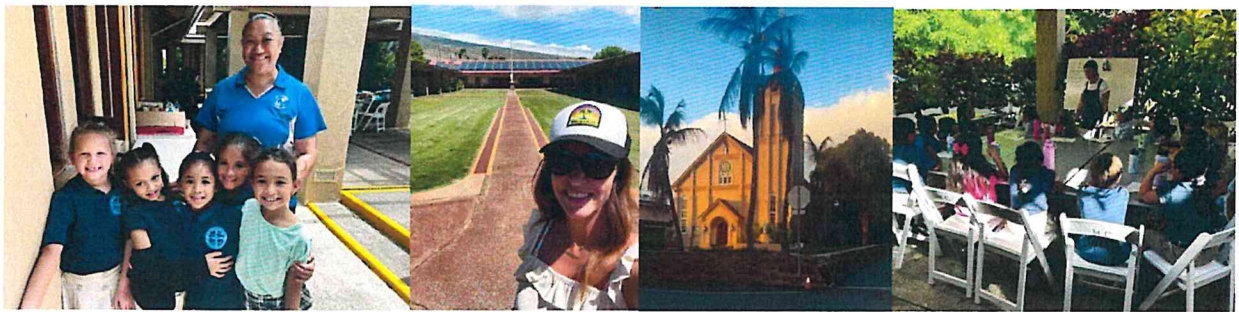
In the month of September, we celebrate the Sisters of Nazareth Core Value of Respect.
