As a Nazareth community, let us say a prayer of remembrance for all those affected by 9/11 during this upcoming 21st anniversary. We shall never forget! On Monday, September 12th, students may wear red, white and blue add-ons with their regular school uniform in honor of Patriot Day.

To keep our students safe, Nazareth School has purchased Securly Classroom for all Chromebooks and Securly Filter for all devices used by students. Securly is a cloud-based solution for filtering our web content and providing teachers with classroom management tools.

Securly Classroom

This chrome extension allows teachers to remotely view students' screens during an active class session. Teachers can lock screens, push URLs to students, limit tabbed browsing, send announcements and answer questions via chat. All activity is recorded and monitored for the safety of students and staff. The Securly Classroom extension is only live during school hours.

Securly Filter

This chrome extension limits what students can access while using their Nazareth domain. Filter blocks sites based on categories that have been deemed unnecessary or inappropriate for students. When a student tries to access a blocked site, administrators are alerted of the URL entered. Administrators are also alerted of any concerning search terms (guns, suicide, pornography, etc.) entered by students. The allow/block list is always a work in progress, as new

sites are created. Please reach out to us if you feel a site needs to be limited or blocked. The Securly Filter extension is active at all times for all devices.

We encourage every student to participate. Simply create an original design on an 8.5x11 white piece of paper and submit your artwork to your teacher.
